

Three Announcements for 10-18-2020

1. As we prepare for our Liturgy on November 1st when we remember our loved ones who have died since All Souls Day last year, we invite you to contact us by phone or email to give us the names of family members you would like to include on the Remembrance Scroll. You do not need to inform us of parishioners who have had funerals or memorial services at the parish. In order to have adequate time to prepare the scroll, the deadline for submitting names is Wednesday, October 21st.

2. As Election Day approaches, we want to support your right and duty to vote. If you or anyone you know needs transportation either to the polls on November 3rd or to a ballot drop box prior to that date, please let us know. We will be happy to provide rides.

3. We are grateful that parishioners have been diligent about observing social distancing and wearing masks so that all can be safe. However, out of an abundance of caution, one of our parishioners has wisely suggested that we should have a plan for contacting Sunday Mass attendees in the event that someone who has attended Mass lets us know that they have tested positive for COVID 19. In that event, we would want to contact everyone who attended the Mass, but we are aware that we may not have accurate phone and email information for everyone, including any guests. For that reason, starting this weekend, we will have clip boards at both side entrances so you can sign your name and phone number and/or email address. We ask you to sign in each week so we have accurate attendance information.
