On Friday, January 11, 2019 the Detroit Catholic Pastoral Alliance will host Rev. Dr. F. Willis Johnson in a Conversation on Racism with Faith and Hope. It will be held from 6:30-8:30 P.M at Sacred Heart Activities Building. There is no charge, free will offerings accepted.

F. Willis Johnson was pastor at Wellspring Methodist Church in Ferguson, MO; at the time of the killing of Michael Brown. The parsonage of the church was directly next door to the Ferguson Police Department. Over the days and weeks that followed Brown's death Johnson had a unique experience where the issues of racism had to be met with faith and hope. The result of this experience is his book "Holding Up Your Corner: Talking about Race in your Community"
