PASTOR'S PEN

Jeremiah reminds us of the Lord's strength in our life:

"Stand up and tell them all that I command you.

Be not crushed on their account,
as though I would leave you crushed before them;
For it is I this day who have made you a fortified city,
a pillar of iron, a wall of brass,
against the whole land:
Against Judah's kings and princes,
Against its priests and people,
They will fight against you but not prevail over you,
For I am with you to deliver you, says the LORD."

The reminder to Jeremiah is the same reminder the Lord has for us. Many times we will feel we are not equal to the tasks we are called to but the Lord stands with us and gives us the strength we need. God says something like this to us: "Remember, I knew you before you were formed in the womb. I have been walking with you all this time. Who do you think has been protecting you up to this point? Please just keep walking and I will take care of everything else." We have the power to do great things.

It's easy to say that God is our strength when life is easy but in those moments when life beats us down or the road seems too steep, we call on these words to surround us like a shield and ask the LORD to remind us of his power and mercy. As we begin Black History month and think of all those who have been part of the struggle for justice and equality, we realize none of us are bystanders. God has put his Word into our hearts and our baptism calls us to be a prophetic voice in our world. Like Jeremiah, we are called to choose. Will we say "yes" to our mission to be part of the movement for justice or will we choose to just be a bystander?

Calling all writers!! We will be inviting people from Nativity and St. Charles to choose a Station of the Cross and provide a short reflection and prayer for our Lenten services. The Stations become so much more meaningful if we adapt them to our life in 2019. Please consider taking on the responsibility of choosing one Station and writing a reflection on it.
