Evangelization Committee Bible Question of the Week

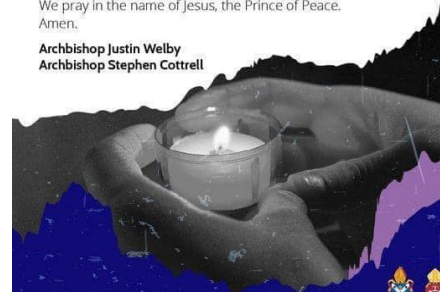
